The pseudocode examples uses the codebox environment. You need to add:

\usepackage{clrscode3e}

at the top of your document.

If your version doesn't automatically find the package, you may also need to:

- 1. download the .sty file from:
 http://www.cs.dartmouth.edu/~thc/clrscode/clrscode.sty
- 2. put it in the same directory as your .tex file (or upload it to your overleaf project directory)
- 3. and you might need to change the package import to:

```
\usepackage{./clrscode}
```
